

Hand Made Flowers



You can make a beautiful bouquet of flowers using your hands and a few simple craft materials.

You will need:

Sheets of coloured paper for flower petals Green paper for leaves Chenille sticks Coloured beads for decoration Safety scissors Sticky Tape





<u>Step 1:</u> Trace your hand onto a colourful sheet of paper. Use safety scissors to cut out the hand shape.





Step 2: Tape a green chenille stick flat on the hand. You can add a coloured chenille stick to the end of the green chenille stick for the centre of the flower.





<u>Step 3:</u> Roll the hand print tightly around the green chenille stick and tape in place. Use your fingers to curl each paper finger. The paper fingers look like flower petals.



<u>Step 4:</u> Cut out the green leaf shapes. Use a hole punch to make a hole so you can slide the leaves onto the chenille stick.



<u>Step 5:</u> Thread a small bead onto the chenille stick to hold the leaves in place.



<u>Step 6:</u> Repeat Steps 1 to 5 to create more flowers. You can use different coloured paper to create a colourful bouquet.



<u>Step 7:</u> Tie your flowers together with a bow made of a colourful chenille stick or ribbon.
